**Chart Definitions** **NECAP:** New England Common Assessment Program standardized state testing, used to determine science proficiency. **PARCC:** Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers; multi-state standardized testing used to determine literacy, algebra and geometry proficiency. **SAT:** The Scholastic Aptitude Test, required for most colleges and universities. The maximum score in each category is 800. **AP:** Advanced Placement, an advanced course and rigorous exam for which high school students can receive college credit. Our data comes from Infoworks, using the most recent education data available.
